



NATAL ASTROLOGY COURSE by Olga Vasilchuk

This course is designed for those who want not only to acquire a solid theoretical foundation in natal astrology, but also to master its practical application. Step by step, you will learn how to understand the structure of a birth chart, interpret its principal elements and create a clear, coherent astropsychological portrait of a person.

The course goes beyond isolated interpretations of planets, signs and aspects. It presents astrology as a complete and structured system in which every element of the birth chart has its own function and interacts with the others. You will learn how to identify psychological patterns, inner motivations, strengths, tensions and the individual ways in which a person relates to the world.

Each birth chart reflects a unique inner structure and a personal set of life patterns. By studying natal astrology, you gain a deeper understanding of yourself and others, as well as practical tools for analysing personality, relationships, professional orientation and individual potential. The course is intended both for beginners and for those who already have some knowledge of astrology but want to develop a more precise, systematic and professional approach.

Requirements

- ✓ No previous knowledge of astrology is required.
- ✓ A genuine interest in natal astrology, astropsychology and self-knowledge.
- ✓ A willingness to study the material progressively and follow the course structure.
- ✓ Readiness to complete practical exercises and homework assignments.
- ✓ Sufficient time for regular study and review of the course materials.

Across Modules 1, 2 and 3, students receive more than 53 hours of audio content across 39 lessons, together with presentation brochures, 29 downloadable handbooks and 24 practical homework assignments personally corrected and commented on by me. The programme also includes free participation in the discussion workshops of the astrological salon “Chez le Verseau” and free access to the workshop recordings. Each module concludes with a two-level final examination leading to certification, followed by the final examination of the Natal Astrology School.

Particular attention is given to the analysis of motivations, inner needs, strengths, tensions, behavioural patterns and professional orientation.
